- The College does not issue split bills. Enrolling parents/guardians are responsible jointly and severally for the payment of College tuition fees and other charges.
- The Fee Schedule is reviewed by the College Board of Directors during the annual budgeting process in November and is subject to change.

- Boarding fees (food component) and boarding activity fees include GST.*

As we are a not-for-profit, low fee independent school, accounts must be paid on time and in accordance with the College Fees Terms and Conditions.

Tuition fees Include:

Tuition fees DO NOT COVER the cost of:

- Textbooks
- Laptops
- Uniforms
- Overnight camps
- Retreats or extra-curricular activities (for example, optional sport and music)

- School diary
- Yearbook
- Courses offered by external providers (for example, TAFE, NSW School of Languages, Sydney Distance Education High School or Southern Cross College).

Building Fund

The College operates a Building Fund and requests donations of \$400 per annum. All donations \$2 and above are tax-deductible and can be included as part of the instalment plan.
